We work even harder each year to organize meaningful events that contribute to the continuous improvement of the learning process.



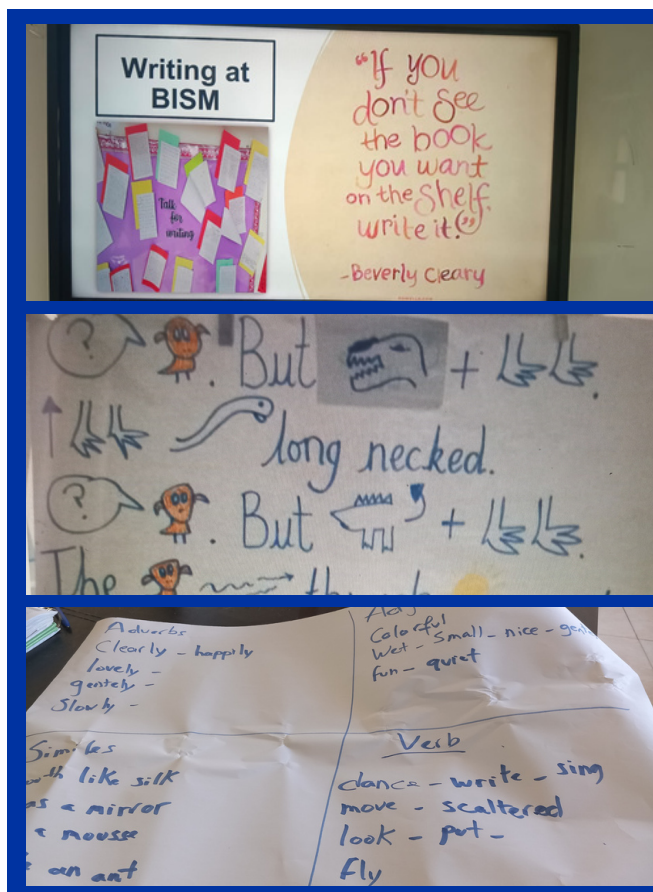
